What was a bare 3-acre paddock now has many pathways which lead past beds of Roses, Iris and perennials creating a lovely cottage feel around the home. The lower end of the garden features a pond with newer plantings of Crab Apple, Flowering cherry and Silver Birch underplanted with bulbs and hellebores creating a peaceful park-like setting.



Whim Park

The Drayshed Nursery and Gardens entrance is lined with Autumn Blaze, just 2 years old. Hidden gardens, secret passageways and eye-catching treasures can be discovered amongst the sweeping green lawns and established trees. Wander amongst the shrubs and blooming bulbs & you will stumble upon the fish pond, or wander down to the dam filled with lily pads in the enchanted 'wild garden'. Take a stroll through the small orchard and say 'Hi' to the farmyard pony, chooks, ducks and family friendly turkeys.



Aberfeldy

Having started life as a paddock in 1994, this garden has developed into a family pleasure with room for entertaining. All the garden beds were created with the "no dig" principle. It features a replica of an old ruins, a stone retaining wall, an Agapanthus garden and of interest is a Newton's Cradle sculpture.



Benning

Situated on the foothills of Mount Panorama this North facing one acre block, developed in 2008 now has a mature, professionally landscaped garden featuring extensive sweeping lawns, hedges, terraces, a large fishpond, ornaments and many gardens. Plantings include an extensive collection of evergreen and deciduous trees, shrubs, perennials, annuals and bulbs that all ensure all round seasonal interest and colour.



Wanera

With lots of hard work from a bare paddock, Tony and Joan have created a lovely garden with many rocks, walls, steps and a variety of trees. The garden contains Roses, Iris, Naked Ladies, Columbines, Camellias and many other beautiful plants. The garden is enhanced by beautiful views over Bathurst to the mountains.



Cambewarra

Cambewarra was built in 1909. Today, the sprawling grounds consist of three acres of recently grown turf, established trees and pathways meandering through the grounds and beautifully manicured hedges. The grounds relate to nature, attracting wild life. The garden is a work in progress, restoration never ending.
