Membership Information

Bathurst Gardeners' Club Incorporated is open to all people who are interested in gardens and gardening — you do not have to be an expert or have a championship garden to be a member. Meetings are held on the first Sunday of each month (except January) commencing at 2pm. At the end of the meetings, we enjoy a cuppa provided by the Club, with members being asked to bring a plate to share. During this time we swap plants, check out the free Seed Bank, swap gardening ideas, endeavour to solve gardening problems, and run a raffle to supplement the Club funds. Members are asked to wear name badges at meetings to foster garden friendships which entitles you to a bonus raffle ticket too!! Gardeners' Club name badges are available for a nominal cost at FIFTY8GEORGE, 58 George Street, Bathurst.

The Club aims to have one overnight trip a year and at least one day trip to areas of interest to gardeners. An informative newsletter is emailed to members every second month.

The Annual General Meeting is held in December to elect our Committee members. The Club begins collecting annual subscription at the December AGM meeting but must be paid by 31st March the following year. Entrance fee is generally around \$5.00 (once only payment) with annual subscription of \$25.00.
