

BGC PLANT AND GARDEN EXPO

Conditions of Entry – 24th October 2020

Visitors are NOT permitted to enter the Plant and Garden Expo if you:

- ◆ are experiencing any flu-like symptoms (sore throat, runny nose, persistent cough, shortness of breath or fever);
- ◆ have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 (during the period of time in which the virus is contagious)
- ◆ are awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19
- ◆ reside with anyone who is awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19
- ◆ have returned from international travel and have failed to observe the government requirement to quarantine for 14 days

Visitors who are not subject to any of the above conditions for exclusion must be willing and able to agree to the following requirements to:

- ◆ leave the site immediately if you become unwell, after notifying a Gardeners' Club Representative;
- ◆ Recommend that visitors, Stall holders and Gardeners' Club representatives wear masks;
- ◆ at all times, maintain social distancing measures, i.e. 1.5 meters apart (as per the NSW Health guidelines) with respect to other visitors, stall holders and Club representatives ;
- ◆ maintain good personal hand hygiene by washing their hands regularly and thoroughly and/or using hand sanitiser;
- ◆ maintain good respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into your elbow or a tissue, and then disposing of tissues immediately;
- ◆ acknowledge that you may be asked to wait, or be refused entry, to the Expo in the event that the site has reached its total capacity under NSW Health social distancing requirements;
- ◆ at all times, treat stall holders, other visitors and Gardeners' Club representatives with respect;
- ◆ Avoid touching your face, nose, mouth where possible;
- ◆ Make payment of items using contactless payment methods where possible;
- ◆ Avoid touching items for sale.
